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

RULES AND GUIDELINES FOR THE BENBROOK AREA CHAMBER OF COMMERCE DEVON ENERGY BBQ COOK-OFF EVENT, 2014

- This event is sanctioned by the International Barbeque Cookers Association (IBCA) and the State of Texas with all rules for judging followed as written by the IBCA. IBCA rules may be found at www.ibcabbq.org.
- Cook Teams may check into the BBQ Cook-Off Grounds beginning at 9:00 a.m., Friday, October 18, 2014 and must be in place by 8:00 p.m. for required judges meeting.
- Categories for the 2014 BACC BBQ Cook-Off Event are as follows:
 - 1. Beef Brisket
 - 2. Chicken (All chickens MUST have a wing tip)
 - 3. Pork Spare Ribs
 - 4. Potluck Pinto Beans
- All meats and beans will be brought to the site RAW...No pre-marinating or pre-spicing prior to official start time. Meat will be inspected at cook site after your check-in. Your official start time is as soon as your meat has been inspected.
- Cooks are to prepare and cook barbeque in as sanitary a manner as possible. Precaution must be made to prevent any fire threat.
- All contest meats and beans will be inspected by a cook-off official at your site after check-in. The official will present you with an official IBCA form, signed off by the official. You will take this form to a designated location in the Judging Facility where you will receive and sign for your trays and foil. Meat may not be removed from the cook site after it has been inspected.
- Cooks Meeting must be attended on Friday, October 17, 2014 beginning at 8:00 p.m. with IBCA Head Judge in the Judging Facility for explanation of rules, any additional instructions and confirmation of turn-in times.
- Judging will begin on Saturday, October 18[,] 2014. Contest meats/beans must be delivered to the designated turn-in point located in the Judging Facility. Turn-in times are as follows:
 - 1. Potluck Pinto Beans: 11:00 a.m.
 - 2. Chicken: 12:00 p.m.
 - 3. Pork Spare Ribs: 1:00 p.m.
 - 4. Beef Brisket: 2:00 p.m.
- Double Blind Judging. You will receive 3 foam trays (plus one for beans if entered) with lids. Each of these trays will have a double matched theatre ticket which has been affixed to the tray with masking tape. The Head Cook only will sign the back of the ticket on each tray. The Head Cook is responsible for removing the signed ticket and putting it in a safe place. You must present this signed ticket to claim any prize when the winning tickets are announced at the award ceremony.
- Any nudity, lewdness, or any form of vulgarity will not be allowed.
- The Head Cook for each team will be responsible for the conduct of the team, guests or invitees. As well, the Head Cook will be responsible for the team's compliance with the rules and grounds regulations. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification. Contestants must not give, offer, sell or donate alcoholic beverages to the general public. Teams will not offer barbeque for sale. Any offensive conduct will be grounds for disqualification form the Cook-Off and expulsion from the Cook-Off Grounds.
- The Benbrook Area Chamber of Commerce and its Directors will not be held responsible for theft or damage to equipment or bodily injury of any kind.
- No motor vehicles will be allowed to enter or exit the Cook-Off Grounds after 10:00 p.m., Friday, October 17, 2014.
- Electric Hook-Ups will be available for a fee of \$30.00 through 4:00 p.m., Saturday, October 18, 2014. Water Hook-Ups not available.
