Proclamation

WHEREAS, multiple cities and towns around the State of Louisiana hold annual, nationally-sanctioned barbecue cook-offs; and

- WHEREAS, Louisiana barbecue has earned high marks in culinary circles and a designated state championship event typically draws a much larger field of competitors, provides a positive economic impact, and raises awareness of barbecue throughout our local communities and throughout the State; and
- WHEREAS, by declaring these events state championships, the winners will have the opportunity to compete in National Championships, including The American Royal and The Jack Daniels Invitational, making each barbecue competition a major event; and

WHEREAS, a Governor's Proclamation is required by National Championship events in order for the contest winners to be eligible to receive an invitation to compete.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, John Bel Edwards, Governor of the State of Louisiana, do hereby proclaim all sanctioned barbecue contests as
