GENERAL RULES AND GUIDELINES

- COOK-OFF ENTRY DEADLINE:** Teams must submit entry forms with fees for the American Legion Post #393 BBQ Cook-Off no later than October 22nd, 2016 , 7:00AM
ENTRY FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE
- SITE AND SETUP:** An area of 30' by 40' will be assigned to each team on a first come, first Served bases. An additional 30' by 40' space is available @ a \$150.00 Charge. Check in time will be Friday October 21st at 1:00PM. Earlier Check in must be approved by the Cook-Off committee. No firearms Of any kind will be allowed in the cook-off area. No pyrotechnics, Explosives or fireworks will be permitted. Violators will face Disqualification and /or removal from the grounds. No electricity Available—MUST provide your own generator. Water is available, must provide own hoses for hook up. Each team is required to have a FIRE EXTINGUISHER PRESENT DURING COOKING TIMES
Cooking fire must be wood, or wood substance (charcoal). Open fires Will not be permitted. No electric or gas grills allowed. BBQ pits may Include gas or electric to start fire of wood or wood substance these must be used to complete cooking.
- HEAD COOK MEETING :** Saturday, October 22nd at 7:30 AM inside the American Legion Post. THIS IS A MANDATORY MEETING, all head cooks or representatives must attend. During this time you will be given your containers, turn in times, and quantities for turn in.
- COOKING CATEGORIES AND RULES:** ALL MEATS WILL BE COOKED ON SITE, no precooking of meat prior to Inspection. Seasoning and margination will not be allowed prior to Inspection. Brisket, pork spareribs, and chicken must be raw when Inspected. Beans must be raw and dry when inspected. A minimum of 1lb of pinto beans prepared on site. Only beans and their juices may be Presented for judges with nothing bigger than the bean. No sauces or Garnishes will be allowed in the judging containers. Sauces may be Used for the cooking process but may not be applied for presentation.

OPEN –meat other than competitive entries. All open categories must Be cooked on site on BBQ pit or grill.

Participants will not be allowed to sell alcohol or barbeque to the General public on premises. Samples may be given to spectators.

BEHAVIOR AND
CONDUCT:

The Head Cook will be responsible for the conduct and behavior of Their team mates and guest. In the event that a member of your team is expelled, it is the Head Cook's responsibility to see that the offending Member or guest is removed from the grounds. In the event the Head Cook is expelled then his designee will ensure the person is removed. If the banned person remains in the area, the offending team may face Disqualification.

Amplified sound systems are to be used with moderation and Consideration of others in the cook-off area. Music with profanity Is strictly prohibited. All sound systems will be turned off at 11:00PM Saturday night, no exceptions.

HOUSE
KEEPING:

Each team is responsible for the maintenance and clean-up of their Assigned areas. All cooking sights must be cleaned before leaving Grounds. Absolutely no beans, grease or trash will be left in the Cook sites.

Absolutely no golf carts or ATV's will be permitted in the cook area, except by the cook-off committee members.

MARGARITAS AND BLOODY
MARYS:

There will be a contest for those wishing to participate. Margaritas and Bloody Marys will be turned in on Friday night October 21st at The designated place, 7:30PM for Margaritas and 8:30PM for Bloody Marys. There will be a \$20.00 fee per entry. One winner 100% pay back. The winner will be announced Friday Oct. 21, 2016 at 10:30 PM in the clubhouse.

JUDGING:

ALL DECISIONS OF THE JUDGING COMMITTEE ARE FINAL.
All entry fees are non-refundable.

Trophies and cash rewards will be awarded Saturday, October 22nd at approximately 6:00PM inside the American Legion Post. **NO DRINKS OF ANY KIND ARE ALLOWED TO BE BROUGHT INSIDE THE POST OR THE FENCED AREA AROUND THE POST PER TABC RULES.** The American Legion Post is licensed thru TABC.
