RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL

- 1. All entry fees must be accompanying the application. The fee is \$150.00 per chief cook and team plus one pit. Spaces will be allocated on a first come first serve basis. There will be electricity available. Generators will be permitted but must have a quiet muffler. There will be water available in the general cook-off area. There will also be port-a-cans available for team and public use.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the cooking team to keep their area clean and assist in garbage disposal. All teams must provide their own trash bags for their own use. There will be a dumpster available for trash clean up.
- 3. Check in will be Friday morning.
- 4. Each cooking team will provide all their supplies and equipment as needed. There will be ice available for purchase on the grounds.
- 5. Holes, dug pits or open flames in boxes or other containers resting on or less than two feet above the ground will not be permitted. No open flames of any kind are permitted.
- 6. Each cooking team will be required to have at least one 2A10BC type fire extinguisher in full view at all times.
- 7. No pets of any kind (except Seeing Eye dogs) will be allowed in the contest area or adjacent parking areas.
- 8. For safety reasons no golf carts, bicycles, motorcycles, water balloons, sling shots, firearms, etc. will be allowed in the contest area.
- 9. This will be a cook-off not a battle of the amps, All music must be kept to a reasonable level and turned off by 1 am
- 10. Each Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of its team members and guests. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants. Each team must keep their alcohol supply out of sight. No open display of large quantities of alcohol will be allowed. Please be discreet as possible. State Law requires that no one under 21 years of age can consume any alcoholic beverages. Anyone violating these laws will be held accountable for their own actions. No parking permitted in cooking area after set up on Friday. Please have all team members and visitors park in the general parking area.

Cooking teams will not be permitted to take down and clean up until Sunday morning.

COOKING & JUDGING

- 1. Contest will be conducted under I.B.C.A. Rules
- 2. Fires must be of wood or wood substance. No gas or electric fires will be permitted.
- 3. No contest meats can be cooked, salted, seasoned or marinated prior to arrival at cook-off.
- 4. Chief Cook meeting will be held at 7:00 pm on Friday night. Only the Chief Cook will need to attend this mandatory meeting. You will be required to turn in one un-cooked brisket Friday night.

5. CATEGORIES: TURN IN TIMES

Fajitas (sliced) beef & chicken Friday 6:00PM
Open (pit cooked) Saturday 10:00AM

(Anything except, ½ whole chickens, pork spare ribs, or beef brisket)

Chicken (2 fully jointed halves) Saturday 12:00PM Pork Spare Ribs (9 cut) Saturday 2:00PM Brisket (9 slices ¼" to 3/8" thick) Saturday 4:00PM

Awards Presentation

- 6. No sauce or garnishment may be put on the contest meat after it has been taken off the pit.
- Only one authorized chief cook per pit. A chief cook and one pit are clarified as being one paid entry.
 Multiple pits are allowed but not multiple chief cooks. TGCBCA/IBCA committeeman will clear this if necessary.
- 8. Each cooking team must also furnish one uncooked brisket to the Arabian Knights.

ADMISTRATION

- 1. The Arabian Knights reserves the night to the modify or expand these rules and regulations due to weather or circumstances as they warrant.
- 2. Decisions by the Chairman and judges are final.
- 3. Security and safety are the sole responsibility of each contestant. The Arabian Knights, Arabian Shrine Center and the Crosby Fairgrounds are not responsible for theft and or damage to the property of contestants, its members or guests. Further the Arabian Knights, Arabia Shrine Center and the Crosby Fairgrounds are not responsible for any injury to any such person. It will be the contestant's responsibility to protect machinery, perishables and exhibits so no injury will result to the public, visitors, guest, persons or property.
