- 6. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies.
- 7. Fires for contest meat must be of wood or wood substances.
- 8. Each team will be responsible for clean-up of assigned space.
- 9. The chief cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guest. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public.
- 10. The Caldwell FFA Boosters will not be liable for theft, damage, or accidents.
- 11. Contest committee reserves the right to make additional changes as situations warrant. Decisions of committee & judges will be final.
- 12. No team golf carts or unauthorized vehicles will be allowed.
