General Information

3rd annual cookin' up a cure

- 1) Registration fee is \$150 to include Brisket, Chicken and Pork Spare Ribs and an optional \$20 for beans
- 2) Check in time starts Friday, July 14 at 10:00 am VFW Post 7110 600 Peace Ave in New Braunfels, TX
- 3) No water or electricity is available on the lots. Water faucet available to fill containers. Portable Potties available near lots. Generators can be used during the day and during “quiet time”.
- 4) Ice will be available for sale on location.
- 5) Alcoholic beverages and non-alcoholic beverages are available at the Post Canteen location. NOTE: State Law requires that you must be 21 years of age to consume alcohol.
- 6) Lot sizes are mostly 20 ft by 40 ft. however some lots will be different in size because of the terrain of the land. Those along the river will be on a first come first paid basis. Please see map of the campground for sizes and layout. Cars/Trucks must be parked within campsite area not on side of roadway. All vehicles left on sides of campsite roadway will be asked to be moved to parking lot. We have to have this clear for emergency vehicles.
- 7) Since this is an event for Relay for Life, where we remember those we have lost to cancer and honor those who have fought that battle and survived or who are still in the battle – we invite you to bring pictures or moments to share at your campsite. Friday we will have available to those interested – white bags with a battery operated candle and a sandbag to weight the bag down. We will sell these for \$5 each. They can be decorated in honor of or in memory of your friend/loved one and Friday night, we encourage you to turn on your candle and light up your campsite so that others can do a luminaria walk thru.
- 8) Saturday we will do a Messages to Heaven balloon release. This is open to the community as well. I have found a place that makes balloons that are earth friendly. So for \$5, you can write a message to a loved one you have lost and we will do a balloon release at a time to be announced a little closer so it doesn't interfere with turn in times.

9) Cooks Meeting is at 8:00 am Saturday, July 15. We will go over all turn in times.

The Payout will be 75% of the monies brought in. Hoping to have First Place \$500; 2nd Place \$350; Third Place \$275; Fourth Place \$225; Fifth Place \$150 in each category with 6th place paying if we get all 50 spots filled. Trophies and certificates will be awarded as well as recognition trophies for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Grand and Reserve will be awarded a Free Entry into the 2018 Cook-Off.

Awards ceremony will be presented on Saturday at approximately 5 pm.

Everyone will have access to the river. Swim at your own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty. If you decide to fish, just abide by Texas Parks and Wildlife guidelines. We also have Cypress Park next to us to fish or walk the service animals. Remember service animals are only allowed in the pit area and Post building

OFFICIAL RULES

- 1) Each team will consist of one head cook with a maximum of 5 members per team
- 2) Decisions of Committee Chairman and Judges are final
- 3) IBCA judging rules apply
- 4) No fundraiser activities or selling of food or products allowed without the consent of Cook-off Committee and VFW
- 5) Meat and beans are subject to inspection and will not leave area after check in.
- 6) All Head Cooks must check in by 8 am Saturday and attend meeting where info and trays will be given.
- 7) By Saturday at 9 am, no vehicles will be permitted into the pit areas. No vehicles, trailers, motor homes and other equipment may exceed the boundary of the contestant's space.
- 8) Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be sold or distributed to the general public.
- 9) No pets or other animals will be allowed in the contest area or in the Post building with the exception of service animals (i.e., seeing eye dogs).
- 10) Loud noise is not permitted. No excessive or loud music is allowed. "QUIET TIME" will be from 12 midnight to 6:00 am. Generators are allowed to run during this time.
- 11) No open pits are allowed. Fires may not be built on the ground. Remember gas or electricity burners may be used to start fire only. Every campsite MUST have a fire extinguisher!!
- 12) No firearms or explosives (including fireworks) are allowed on location.
- 13) The BBQ Chairperson reserves the right to make additional rules or regulations as situations warrant. The Chairperson also reserves the right to disqualify any team that does not abide by the rules.
