

INDIVIDUAL RULES

Rules:

- 1. Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas and electricity to start natural substance.
- 2. No pit area should be allowed to project beyond their assigned space and teams are not allowed to take contents of their booth out of the assigned space including the distribution of literature or material. Props, trailers, motor homes, tents and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space.
- 3. Only one team allowed per space.
- 4. All outdoor tents must be anchored.
- 5. All teams, their agents or employees, shall be responsible for any injury or defacing to the grounds of the facilities or the booths or equipment of other teams.
- 6. No extra vehicles will be allowed in the pit area once the pit is set up. Motor home is considered one vehicle. No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, ATV's, golf carts or battery powered vehicles allowed with the exception of handicapped.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean and policed following the contest.
- 8. All fires must be put out and all building materials and props must be hauled away and equipment removed from site.
- 9. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. TABC rules must be followed. **Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public.** No glass drinking containers or bottles allowed.
- 10. Promoter and cook officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft or any mishaps.
- 11. Handicap restrooms and water are available. Electrical and water hook-ups are available for travel trailers or motor homes at an additional charge. A paid entry reserves a space with electrical hook ups. Limited availability.
- 12. No excessive or loud music allowed. Quiet time will be from 12 a.m. 7 a.m. Generators will be allowed to operate during quiet time.
- 13. South 40 Committee Officials reserve the right to adjust or make booth assignments up to and including the date of move-in.
- 14. No food, drinks or products may be sold without the expressed written consent of the South 40 Committee.
- 15. Entry fees are non-refundable. Cook-off will not be cancelled due to inclement weather.
- 16. This agreement shall not be assigned, and no rights granted to the team in this agreement shall be subcontracted without the written consent of the South 40 Committee.
- 17. No ground pits will be used and all burn barrels will have some sort of safety barrier placed across the top or around the barrel.
- 18. Team name and conduct must be appropriate for a family audience.
- 19. IBCA cooking and judging rules will apply only to Individual Teams. These rules can be found at www.south40outdoorexpo.com.
- 20. Jackpot Beans—there can be nothing bigger than the bean in the cup. If so then automatic disqualification.
- 21. South 40 Committee Officials reserve the right to disqualify any team that does not abide by the rules.
