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#### Mandatory – Meat will be inspected before you may begin seasoning.

- 1. Holes or open pits are not permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. **Each team MUST bring a fire extinguisher.**
- 2. Props, trailers, motor home vehicles, tents and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space. No tent stakes can be driven into the asphalt.
- 3. It is the responsibility of the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean and that the area is cleaned and policed following the contest. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks and other building materials or props hauled away, and all equipment removed from the site.
- 4. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualifications. Alcoholic beverage rules must be followed (example: poured into cups). Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants. No food sales to the general public.
- 5. 1 vehicle per pit site. No extra vehicles shall be allowed in the pit area once pit is setup. Motorhome/travel trailer is considered as one (1) vehicle. There will be additional parking for assistant cook vehicles in a designated area close to the competition.
- 6. No 4 wheelers or golf carts in cook-off area except by the cook-off promoter.
- 7. Promoter and cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft, or any mishaps.
- 8. No Skateboards, skates, in-line skates, bicycles allowed.
- 9. No electricity available bring your own generators.
- 10. Spaces are approximately 35 x 40.
- 11. Absolutely no firearms or explosives are allowed.
- 12. Amplification should be used in moderation during the entire cook-off and must be turned off from midnight Friday until 8am Saturday. You will be given a warning and are subject to disqualification on second complaint.
- 13. Check in times begin Thursday after 6pm. Due to the size of our event and safety of pedestrians. ALL COOKS MUST BE CHECKED IN BY 6:00 AM SATURDAY.
- 14.Buck's Backyard and IBCA reserves the right to make additional regulations as situations warrant. Decisions of Committee and Judges are FINAL.
