Rules & Regulations

- 1.) Teams may check in and set up after 12:00 p.m. on May 5th at the West Texas Food Bank in the designated cooking grounds. No electricity will be provided but generators are welcome.
- 2.) This is an IBCA sanctioned event. Complete cooking rules and turn in requirements can be found on IBCA website http://ibcabbq.org/wp-content/uploads/Feb-14-2017-Rules.pdf
- 3.) Fires must be of wood or charcoal. The use of gas or electricity may only be used for the Beans category.
- 4.) The BBQ teams, guests, and others in attendance must adhere to event ground rules.
 - All personal alcoholic beverages must remain in the cooking area. No Glass Containers
 are Allowed. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification.
 Please drink responsibly. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be given to
 minors. Alcohol is not allowed to leave the event area.
 - Be courteous & respectful to your fellow participants & others attending the event.
 - Keep your cooking area clean at all times during and immediately following the cook-off. All fires must be put out and all equipment and trash shall be removed from your cooking area by May 6th at 7pm. You will be responsible for the cleanliness of your area.
 - Each team must bring/provide a fire extinguisher for their own cooking area.
 - Keep pits, trailers, canopies (no stakes shall be nailed into the pavement), equipment, etc. in your assigned area.
- 5.) No open pits or ground fires are allowed.
- 6.) You must cook all three meats to qualify for the Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. In the event of a tie for Grand Champion, brisket will be used as a tie breaker.
- 7.) Cooks meeting will be held Friday, May 5^{th} at 7:00 p.m.
- 8.) The tentative turn in times on May 6^{th} are as follows:
 - **Beans-** 11:00 a.m.
 - **Chicken-** 12:00 p.m.
 - **Ribs** 1:30 p.m.
 - **Brisket** 3:00 p.m.
 - **Dessert**-4:00 p.m.
- 9.) Award Ceremony will begin at 5:00 p.m.
