

Rules & Regulations

- 1. This is an **International Bar-B-Que Cookers Assoc. Sanctioned BBQ Cook-off**. All IBCA rules will apply (see rules at: www.ibcabbq.org). You do <u>not</u> have to be a member of IBCA to cook.
- 2. **Regular arrival & set-up** is Friday, June 24th (8:00am to 8:00pm). **Early set-up** on Thursday, June 23rd is allowed, for bringing in some of your equipment.
- 3. <u>Deadline for entry</u> is 6:30pm Friday (at chief cook's meeting). Teams must depart by 2:00pm on Sunday.
- 4. **Spaces will be 40 x 40** (can accommodate larger if needed for larger RV's). Pop-ups, Trailers, and Motor homes are allowed. Vehicles and other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space. Spaces are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 5. **Bring generators no electricity available at sites. There will be a source for water** but you will need your own holding containers.
- 6. Teams will consist of one (1) Chief Cook & four (4) team members. Each team must cook on their own Pit.
- 7. All fires used to prepare meat in this contest must be of wood/wood products, or charcoal. No gas or electric Cooking equipment will be allowed for contest meats (except for Open Jackpot). You may use propane to start your fire.
- 8. **No pre-seasoning or pre-cooking** of the meat is allowed. Teams may be subject to random meat inspections. Meats must not leave the cook-off site.
- 9. **No sauces or garnishes** may be added to judging container. Sauce & Mops may be used during cooking.
- 10. Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team & guests. The excessive use of alcoholic beverages shall be grounds for disqualification. **Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be sold to the General Public, or given to a MINOR.**
- 11. It is the responsibility of the BBQ cooking teams to keep their area clean and to make sure it is left clean following the contest (PLEASE). Each team is responsible for bagging and disposing of their trash into the dumpsters provided.
- 12. QUIET TIME IS 12 MIDNIGHT... PLEASE!!
- 13. If you have a DJ or a Band, respect your neighbors. If you have large amps or speakers, please keep them turned in toward your spot.
- 14. Cooks Meeting is at 6:30pm on Friday, June 24th. Containers will be given out at this time. THIS IS A MANDATORY MEETING. ALL CHIEF COOKS MUST ATTEND.
