IBCA Rules

- 1. NOTE . only one team per pit.
- 2. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and up to 4 team members.
- Any and all meat and/or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, etc., will not be allowed prior to the start of the cook-off as defined by cook-off promoter.
- 4. Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start the natural substances, but not to complete cooking. Holes or open pits are not permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. Each team must bring a fire extinguisher.
- 5. Props, trailers, motor home vehicles, tents and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestants assigned space. No tent stakes can be driven into the asphalt.
- 6. Cooks Meeting will be held on Sunday at 9 a.m. in the Judging area (Diamond Club). Head Cooks must attend.
 - a. ½ chicken Fully jointed split chicken (with breast, wing with tip, thigh and drumstick with skin on). No Cornish Game Hens.
 - b. Pork SPARE Ribs 7 individual ribs (bone in . St Louis cut acceptable)
 - c. Brisket 7 full slices (approx ¼+. 3/8+thick)

 No garnish or sauce is allowed in tray at turn-in. You can cook with sauce but it cannot be ladled onto the meat.
- 7. It is the responsibility of the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean and that the area is cleaned and policed following the contest. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks, and other building materials or props hauled away and all equipment removed from the site.
- Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualifications.
 Alcoholic beverage rules must be followed (example: poured into cups, no glass).
 Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to general public by contestants.
- 9. No extra vehicles shall be allowed in the pit area once pit is setup. Two vehicle maximum if contained within space.
- 10. IBCA judging rules will apply.
- 11. Promoter and cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft or any mishaps.
- 12. No Skateboards, skates, in-line skates, or ATV/golf carts allowed.
