# PEÑITAS WHITEWING FESTIVAL COOK-OFF

A Non-Profit Organization  
RULES AND REGULATIONS

Peñitas Whitewing Festival LTD. has written all the rules for judging & IBCA.

**TEAMS:** A team will consist of a Chief Cook and four assistants (5 Total). The Chief Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of the team. Quiet time is from 12:00 am to 6:00 am Saturday and only moderate amplification during the day. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages, as well as disruptive behavior and/or improper conduct, will be grounds for disqualification. Teams are only allowed to bring a limit of (4) 12pk of beer (only for team of 5). Additional beer can be purchased at a discounted price at the event. Each team will receive one (1) parking permit; this permit must be displayed on the windshield of the vehicle. For safety reasons only one vehicle will be allowed within the cooking site. All other vehicles must be parked outside the cook-off area (parking lot). No vehicles will be allowed in or out of the cook-off area after 9:00am Saturday morning. This is to keep from overcrowding and to allow easy access for Fire and EMS. Move out time will be after 6:00pm Saturday, September 21, 2013 or can stay for the concert but can't be moving vehicles.

**COOKS MEETING:** A mandatory Head Cooks meeting will be held Saturday, September 21, 2013 at 8:00am. Head Cook will be required to attend the meeting.

**COOKED ON SITE:** All meats must be cooked on-site. No pre-seasoning or pre-cooking allowed. All preparation of entries can begin after meat has been inspected by the promoter or an Official IBCA Head Judge. Meat inspection will be done Friday afternoon or Saturday before Head Cooks meeting. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. There must be at least (1) fire extinguisher per pit on site provided by the cook team.

**SANITATION:** Cooks prepare and cook in as sanitary manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by judging committee. Infractions identified by the judging committee shall be immediately corrected or the cook will be subject to disqualification. During and after the event we ask that trash be placed in trash cans and dumpsters.

**ENTRIES PER PIT:** IBCA recognizes only one entry (one chief cook) will cook on a given pit. It will be the responsibility of the promoters to monitor entries. Multiple entries in the same IBCA category by the same cook and/or multiple entries from the same piece of meat shall not be allowed. These are all grounds for disqualifications.

**BBQ PITS:** All fires must be in containers, not on the ground.

**OPEN GROUND FIRES: NO OPEN GROUND FIRES ARE PERMITTED!**

## CATEGORIES:

**BRISKET:** seven (7) full slices approximately 1/4" to 3/8" thick

**PORK SPARE RIBS:** Turn in 7 individual cut ribs (bone in) NO BABYBACKS

**CHICKEN:** Turn in one half (1/2) fully jointed domestic chicken with skin that includes a breast, wing with tip, thigh, and drumstick. (NO Cornish Game Hens)

**If an event has 50+ teams,** it is recommended that two (2- 1/2) chickens be submitted for judging and that the brisket and pork "spare" rib quantities be adjusted accordingly.

**Beans** – Dry pinto beans cooked on site, nothing larger than the bean to be put into the turn-in cup.

**Whitewing (paloma)** - Grilled

**Pan de Campo** –Traditional Pan de Campo

**Fajitas** – Traditional inside/outside skirt only – NO sirloin Fajitas

**BEST CAMPSITE:** Judging will be conducted by guest judges throughout the day. Teams will be judged on showmanship, campsite cleanliness, and best festive atmosphere.

**JUDGING:** Barbeque will be judged on aroma, appearance, color, taste, and overall impression. Judging will be under

the direction of an IBCA Head Judge. **THE DECISIONS OF THE JUDGES ARE FINAL.**

**TURN-IN TIMES:** Once the time is set and/or announced, no changes will be made. A turn in window of ten (10) minutes before and after the set turn in times will be recognized. Judging trays received before or after that time will not be accepted for judging.

**PRIZES:** IBCA states that a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion be named at every cook-off. In the event of a tie for Grand Champion, Brisket will be the first tie breaker, followed by ribs, then chicken.

**ITEMS NOT ALLOWED:** No pets allowed. No skateboards, tricycles, bicycles, motorcycles, mopeds, three wheelers, four wheelers or golf carts will be permitted on premises, with the exception of those used by member of the **Peñitas Whitewing Festival** members or handicapped individuals who have made arrangements with the promoter prior to the event.

**CHECK IN:** Check in time will be Friday, September 20, 2013 from 5:00pm and 10:00pm. The City of Peñitas, Peñitas Whitewing Festival Ltd, Mil Encinos Development Ltd nor the sponsors of this event will be held responsible for any theft or damage of property or bodily injury. The Penitas Whitewing Festival Board reserves the right to adjust regulations as situations warrants decisions of the Peñitas Whitewing Festival and Judges will be final.
