2nd Annual Avoyelles Arts & Music Fest Bar-B-Q Cook-Off Rules and Regulations

(Sanctioned by the International Barbeque Cookers Association)

- 1. ENTRY FEES Three meat categories (half chicken, pork spare ribs, and beef brisket) cost \$110. Two jackpot categories of sauce, and burgers cost \$10 each category per team. Payment of the entry fee for all categories is due by time of arrival on July, 3, 2013 if you wish to compete. Due to restricted space we only have room for 35 teams. Teams will be accommodated on a 1st come, 1st served basis.
- 2. COOKED ON SITE All entries must be cooked on-site. The preparation and completion of all entries in competition must be within the confines of the cook-off site during the day of the competition. All competition meat is subject to inspection.
- 3. SANITATION Cooks are to prepare and cook in as sanitary of a manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by judging committee. Infractions identified by the judging committee shall be immediately corrected or the cook will be subject to disqualification. No processing of animals to obtain meat for the cook-off will be allowed on the premises.
- 4. ENTRIES PER PIT Only one entry of no more than five (5) people (one chief cook) will cook on a given pit. Multiple entries in the same category by the same cook and multiple entries from the same piece of meat shall not be allowed. Contestants must be 18 years of age to participate (due to IBCA regulations on contests with cash prizes).
- 5. BBQ PITS The following types of pits will be allowed for use in cooking meat:
- a. Pit Any commercial or homemade, trailered or un-trailered, pit or smoker normally used for competitive barbeque. A BBQ Pit may include gas or electricity for starting the combustion of wood or wood products but NOT to complete cooking.
- b. BYC (Backyard Cooker) any cooking device by design or nature that is inherently portable and by design is intended for recreational cooking.
- 6. OPEN FIRES No open fire or ground pits are to be used. A fire extinguisher shall be readily available.
- 7. CATEGORIES Entrants will turn-in Half Chicken, Pork Spare Ribs, and Beef Brisket in this IBCA sanctioned contest. Specific rules, list of turn-in times, and a review of judging procedures will be discussed at a mandatory head cooks meeting, scheduled on Wednesday, July 3, 2013 at 7:00 pm. All IBCA rules will be used in this contest. A list of these rules are shown on the IBCA website, http://www.ibcabbq.org/rules.html.
- 8. VEHICLES Due to limited space, all vehicles will be limited to assigned areas.
- 9. ACCESS The cook-off area will open Wednesday, July 3, 2013 at 12:00 pm. Contestants will be able to register and check meat at the registration booth beginning at 12:00 pm. Each registered contestant will be assigned a cook site. Water is available but you will need to bring your own container. Electricity is available this year.
