Fourth Annual IBCA Sanctioned Texas State Championship Cook-Off

Benefiting the Scholarship Fund and Partnership in Education

Rules and Regulations:

1. Neither Beaumont Masonic Lodge # 286 nor Beaumont's Elk Lodge will be held responsible for Theft, Bodily injury or Damage to property while at this event.
2. This is an I.B.C.A Sanction Texas State Championship Cook-off, and therefore all their rules will apply.
3. You do not have to be Masonic or a member of IBCA to cook in this event.
4. Only 1 team per pit for sanctioned events.
5. Trophies and Prize Money will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, & 3rd places in each Meat Category. Prize Money will be given in the Minimal amounts of 1st \$150.00, 2nd \$100.00, 3rd \$50.00, pending the number of entries and donations given.
6. An overall Grand Champion will be determined by a points system using the 3 meat categories. Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion will receive a Trophy.
7. Meat Categories are as follows. Beef Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs (no baby back ribs), and ½ Jointed Chicken. Other Categories include Pinto Beans, Open, Dessert, and Daiquiri.
8. Fires MUST be of wood or wood substance (pellets) or Charcoal. Gas or Electricity may be used to Ignite fires, but not for final cooking. NO hole or dug pits will be allowed.
9. NO Pre-seasoning of meats will be allowed. All meats MUST be prepared and cooked on sites. Preparing of meats may begin upon completion of inspection of meats. Inspection will be done upon arrival or earliest convenience of the cooks and coordinator.
10. It is the responsibility of the contestant to keep their designated areas free of trash and clutter. A central Dumpster will be available to place trash in.
11. Cooking Areas will be determined on First come first serve Basis starting on Friday May 17th 2013 starting at 9am-10pm.

12. Water and electricity will be provided. Slots for Campers are available from the Elks Lodge for a fee of \$10.00 Per night. Please Notify Cook-off personnel or Elk's Lodge if bringing in a camper.
13. There will be no food or beverages sold by the contestants. Contestants MAY receive donations for food cooked. (tip jars are allowed)
14. 1 cooked brisket is to be turned in to Cook-Off Officials prior to 10am on Saturday May18th for sale of plate lunches by the Masons and Elks. A tax deductible receipt of \$40.00 will be given to each team captain for the donation.
15. All Containers will be distributed at the cooks meeting. Any altered containers will be grounds for disqualification. Minimal of Head Cook must attend the Cook's Meeting which will be held at 6pm on Friday May 17th in the main hall of the Elks Lodge.
16. Team Captain's are responsible for the actions of their team members and their guest.
17. The Rules Committee reserves the right to make additional regulation as the situation may warrant.
18. Any of the teams found in violation of said rules and regulations are subject to disqualification.
