Official Rules

Any questions regarding rules regarding Cindy Riehs Memorial Cook-off, you can contact Head Judge Josh Kovar and be present at Cookers Meeting 3/31 at 6:30 at the Inez Community Center

1. All meats will be raw, **NO** pre-marinating prior to the start of the cook-off, teams can start cooking once inspection of meat is made. **(All meats must be inspected prior to cooking.)**
2. One entry fee pays for one team. Team consists of your (1) head cook and (4) assistant cooks.
3. All pits must use wood or wood substance (Charcoal) fires. You may however use gas or electricity installed starters to start your fire. (pellet cookers allowed)
4. Open fires, holes or open pits will NOT be permitted cooking. Each team needs to have a fire extinguisher visible at each camp in case of fire.
5. Each team will be provided with a 30'X30' space. The spaces will be assigned upon receipt of entry-fee. **Pre-Pay your entry fee to pick your space.** Please use only that space for pits, travel/motor trailers, tents or any props or equipment that will be used during the cook-off. **No vehicle will be allowed in the cook-off area once the competition has begun.**
6. Chicken, Pork Spare Ribs, and Brisket. Jackpot categories are optional for teams with a separate payout system paying winner takes ½ of entry fees collected ½ to Memorial Fund. Brisket 1st place \$1000 2nd \$500 3rd \$250 4th \$150 5th \$100 Chicken & Ribs 1st Place \$500 2nd \$250 3rd \$150 4th \$75 5th \$25
7. Jackpot Items Beans, Chefs Choice, and Dessert will be cooked on site and cannot be pre-cooked, or pre-marinated. Chefs Choice and Dessert turn in will be Friday Night at 7:30 and 8:00. Beans will be announced at cookers meeting.
8. There will be ten (10) minute window before and after each stated turn in time.
9. The Hospice of South Texas, Cindy Riehs Memorial, Inez Community Center, and the cook-off officials will NOT be held responsible for any accidents, theft, or any incidents.
10. Bagged Garbage will be picked up **BRING YOUR OWN GARBAGE CAN** we want to keep the facility clean and welcome for visitors. Cooks are responsible for preparing and cooking their food in a sanitary manner. Drip pans must be in place for every fire and pit.
11. Judging trays will be provided with a double ticket one for you and the taped one to stay to tray for a secret ballot, marked containers will be disqualified.
 - a. Chicken: (2) Two (1/2) half a chicken fully jointed. Wing, breast, leg, and thigh.
 - b. Pork Spare Rib: Nine (9) individual cut ribs must be turned in. (With bone)
 - c. Brisket: Nine (9) full slices cut approximately one-fourth (1/4") to three-eighths (3/8") inch thick.
 - d. No pudding in bottom of tray allowed
