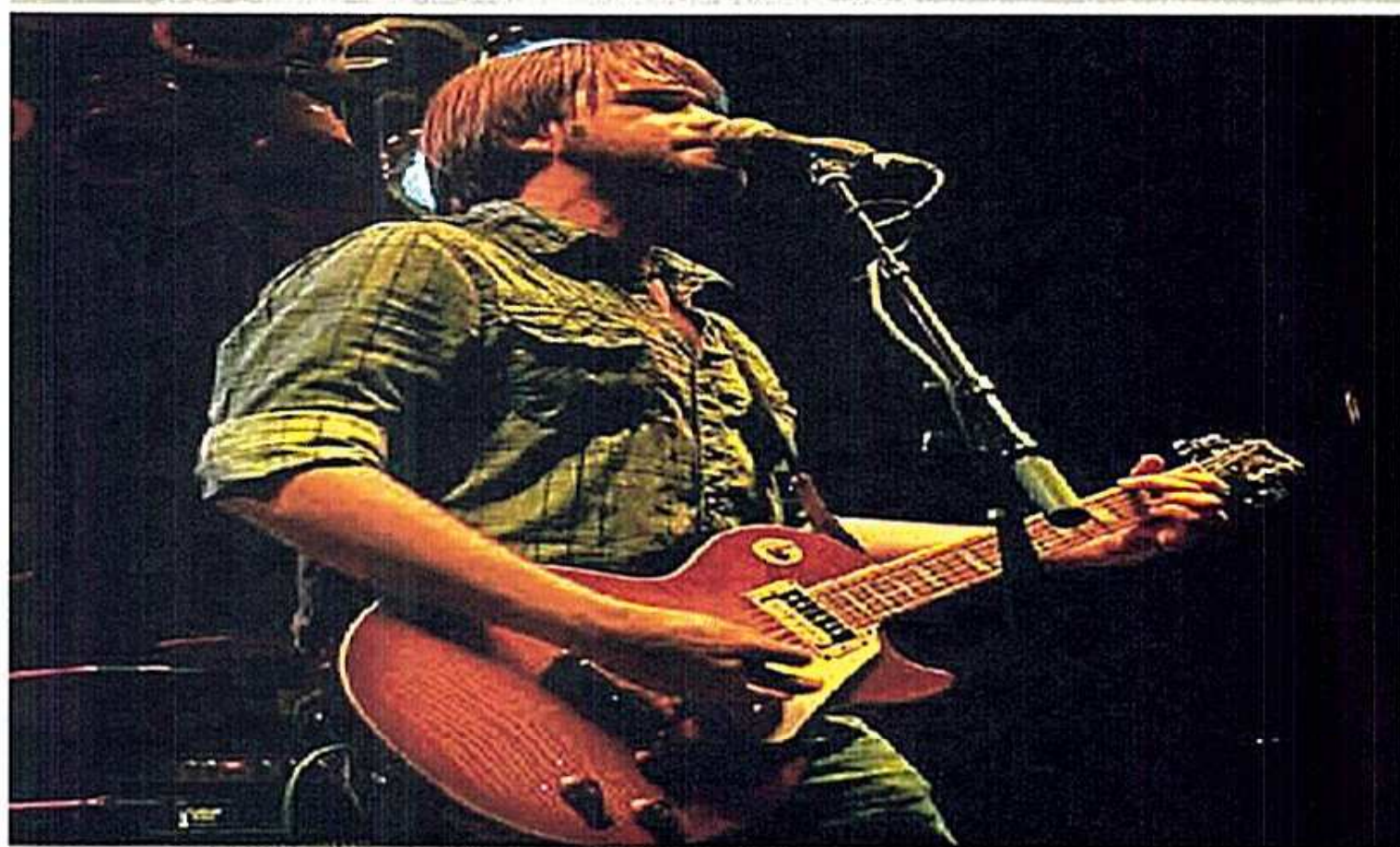




## Cook-Off Rules

1. Entry forms for the BBQ Cook-Off may be obtained from any member of the DeKalb Kiwanis or email us your request at [dekalbkiwanisbbq@yahoo.com](mailto:dekalbkiwanisbbq@yahoo.com)
2. All judging will be according to IBCA Rules.
3. Head cooks meeting will be held 7:00 p.m. Friday at DeKalb City Park. Head cooks must attend. Meat will be inspected upon arrival. Containers will be handed out at cooks meeting.
4. Move in Thursday to final move in Friday 9:00 p.m. Quiet time outside is 11:00 p.m. each night. You are welcome to stay Saturday evening but it is asked that you clear the area by noon on Sunday. **No** RV hook-ups are available.
5. The Chief Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his team and guests. It is also their responsibility to keep the contestant area clean. IBCA recognizes only one entry (one chief cook) can cook on a given BBQ pit.
6. All decisions from the judges and promoter are final.
7. All three meats will count to Grand Champion. In the event of a tie for Grand Champion, brisket will be the first tie breaker, followed by ribs, then chicken.
8. Meats may be cooked with sauces and/or other liquids, but once the cooking is complete, sauces and/or liquids cannot be added once put into tray. **NO PUDDLING IN TRAY.**
9. Fires must be charcoal, wood or wood substance for cooking chicken, pork spare ribs and brisket. All fires must be contained in a suitable manner. Contestants may be disqualified if precautionary measures are not followed or unsafe conditions exist. Teams must carry a working fire extinguisher.
10. Holes or dug pits are not permitted. Any equipment or devices that may damage the surface area of the contest site in any way are prohibited.
11. Contestants may have vehicles in the contest area during designated set-up times only. After set-up all vehicles must be moved to the contestant parking area. Please no ATVs or RTVs (3-wheelers, 4-wheelers, Gators, etc).
