Cook-off check in begins Friday September 13th at 3PM

Cooks meeting Friday September 13th at 7:30PM

The head cook of each team will be responsible for the conduct and behavior of his/her team. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages will be grounds for immediate disqualification and removal from cook-off grounds. Outside adult beverages are to be confined to your cook-site and consumed in a discrete manner.

The IBCA; Childress Chamber of Commerce; the City of Childress and their officials; and representatives will not be held responsible for accidents, theft or damages to equipment, property or persons competing or attending this event.

The Childress BBQ Cook-Off is open to all individuals without regard to race, color, sex, disability, religion, age, national origin, genetic information or veteran status.

Meats may be cooked with sauces and/or other liquids, but once the cooking is complete, sauces and/or liquids may not be added once put into tray.

Sweets Categories:

- A. Pie- Must provide at minimum of 3 PIES. must be cooked at home or other location and brought to location for judging.
- B. Other- you may enter a sweet that is not a pie and it must be cooked at home. (for questions please contact us)

Turn-In / Judging Schedule: Saturday. September 14, 2019

- 11:00 am Beans
- 12:00 noon Chicken two (2) separate ½ fully jointed chickens (to include breast, wing, thigh and drumstick. SKIN ON (No Cornish Game Hens).
- 1:30 pm Nine (9) individual cut ribs (bone in). St. Louis cut acceptable. Ribs must be placed in the tray with meat side up lying parallel to the hinge.
- 3:00 pm Nine (full slices, recommended ¼" to 3/8" thick- Meat side up. Slices may be blocked (trimmed to fit container) after cooking is complete, however, these must be complete slices, not pieces.
