GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1) Registration fee is \$150 to include brisket, chicken, and pork spare ribs. Optional choices include \$20 for beans, \$25 for Cook's Choice, and \$25 for KidsQue per child.
- 2) Check-in time starts Friday, July 13 at 8:00 am at the VFW Post 7110 located at 600 Peace Ave, New Braunfels, TX. Cook's Choice will be Friday, July 13 at 6:30 pm.
- 3) Head Cooks meeting is Saturday, July 14 at 8:00 am. We will go over all turn in times. Coffee and breakfast for Team Captains at 7:00 am.
- 4) **New This Year** - POT LUCK DINNER – Friday, July 13 at 7:00 pm in the VFW Post building, following the Cook's Choice judging – bring food to share! Paper goods, tea, and ice will be supplied. There will also be washer boxes and horseshoes!
- 5) No water or electricity is available on the lots. Water faucet available to fill containers. Portable toilets available near lots. Generators can be used during the day and during "quiet time".
- 6) Ice will be available for sale on location.
- 7) Alcoholic beverages and non-alcoholic beverages are available at the VFW Post Canteen.
NOTE: State Law requires that you must be 21 years of age to consume alcohol.
- 8) Lot sizes are mostly 30'x40'; however some lots will be different in size because of the terrain of the land. Those along the river will be on a first come, first **PAID** basis. The new lot sizes will vary from 25'x40' to 30'x40'. Please see map of the campground for layout. Cars/trucks must be parked within campsite area and not on side of roadway. All vehicles left on the side of the campsite roadway will be asked to be moved to the parking lot. Campsite roadways have to remain clear for emergency vehicles.
- 9) Since this is an event for Relay for Life; it is an opportunity to support and honor those who have survived, those who are still fighting, and to remember those who lost their battle – we invite you to bring pictures or mementos to share at your campsite.
- 10) Everyone will have access to the river. There is no lifeguard on duty, swim at your own risk. If you decide to fish, just abide by Texas Parks and Wildlife guidelines. Cypress Bend Park next to us to fish or walk the service animals. Remember service animals are the only animals allowed in the pit area and VFW Post building.

The Payout will be 75% of the monies brought in. Hoping to have 1st Place \$500, 2nd Place \$350, 3rd Place \$275, 4th Place \$225, 5th Place \$150 in each category with 6th place paying if we get all 50+ spots filled. Trophies and certificates will be awarded as well as recognition trophies for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Grand and Reserve will be awarded a Free Entry into the 2019 Cook-Off.

Beans payout will be 60% of the monies brought in; with 1st place at 40%, 2nd place at 20%, 3rd through 5th will receive certificates.

Cook's Choice payout will be 60% of the monies brought in; with 1st place at 40%, 2nd place at 20%, 3rd through 5th will receive certificates.

Awards ceremony will be Saturday, July 14 at approximately 6:00 pm.

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OFFICIAL RULES

1. Each team will consist of one (1) head cook with a maximum of five (5) members per team
2. Decisions of Committee Chairman and Judges are final
3. IBCA judging rules apply
4. No fundraiser activities or selling of food or products allowed without the consent of Cook-off Committee and VFW
5. Meat and beans are subject to inspection and will not leave area after check in.
6. All Head Cooks must check in by 8:00 am Saturday and attend meeting where information and trays will be given.
7. No vehicles will be permitted into the pit areas after 9am on Saturday. No vehicles, trailers, motor homes, and other equipment may exceed the boundary of the contestant's space.
8. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be sold or distributed to the general public.
9. No pets or other animals will be allowed in the contest area or in the VFW Post building with the exception of service animals (i.e., seeing eye dogs).
10. Loud noise is not permitted. No excessive or loud music is allowed. "QUIET TIME" will be from midnight to 6:00 am. Generators are allowed to run during this time.
11. No open pits are allowed. Fires may not be built on the grounds. Remember gas or electricity burners may be used to start fire only. Every campsite **MUST** have a fire extinguisher!!
12. No firearms or explosives (including fireworks) are allowed on location.
13. The BBQ Chairperson reserves the right to make additional rules or regulations as situations warrant. The Chairperson also reserves the right to disqualify any team that does not abide by the rules.
