- * Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team & guests. The excessive use of alcoholic beverages shall be grounds for disqualification. **Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be sold to the General Public or given to a MINOR.**
- * It is the responsibility of the Bar-B-Que team to see that the contest area is kept clean and the area is clean following the contest. (PLEASE) There will be a dumpster provided to dispose of the trash. If you leave your area trashed you will not be invited back.
- * **QUIET TIME IS 12 MIDNIGHT....PLEASE!!**
If you have a DJ or a Band, respect your neighbors. This is not a battle of the speakers. If you have large amps or speakers keep them turned in toward your spot.
- * Spaces will be 30x30 and 30x20. Pop-ups, Trailers, and Motorhomes are allowed. Vehicles and other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestant's assigned space. Electrical hookups are not available.
- * Water is available at a common location. There will be ice for sale.
- ** Cooks Meeting is at 6:30pm on Friday November 16th, 2018. Containers will be given out at this time. **THIS IS A MANDATORY MEETING. ALL CHIEF COOKS MUST ATTEND.**
