# 2019 Saddle Up for Alzheimer's BBQ Cook-Off Rules & Guidelines

The Saddle Up for Alzheimer's BBQ Committee welcomes you to the 2019 BBQ Cook-Off. All cook-off teams are required to submit a registration form and entry fee as outlined in these rules and guidelines, no credit can be extended.

1. **Entry Fee**: \$150.00 per team includes water hook up. Contestants must contact the Brackenridge Main Event Center to reserve their spot with electrical hook up, a receipt will be provided and you will need to present receipt at check-in. Contestants that do not have a reserved spot will be assigned one on a first come basis. Jackpot categories; Beans \$10.00, Chef's Choice \$20.00, and Kids Q \$15.00.

Teams shall consist of one (1) Head Cook and up to three (3) team members (collectively "contestants").

- 2. **Mandatory Meeting**: A Head Cook meeting will take place at 7 pm in the Judging Area on Friday, August 16, 2019.
- 3. **Cooked On Site**: All meat entries must be prepared and cooked on site.
- 4. Cook-Off Site: A 20'x30' cook-off site will be provided. Cook-off campsite set-up will start on Friday, August 16, 2019 at 9 am and ending at 10 pm. Water and electrical hook-ups are available and will be reserved by contacting Brackenridge Main Event Center. Tap water will be available at the location. All outdoor tents and canopies must be anchored with water barrels or sandbags. Under no circumstances are teams to drill holes or tent stakes in the concrete or asphalt of the premises. If said damage is found to be present, the team will be fully responsible for repairing the damages to the Brackenridge Main Events specification. Security will be provided. TEAR DOWN of Cook-off site may begin on Saturday after 3 pm and all equipment shall be off the grounds no later than Sunday, August 17, 2019 by 1 pm. It is the responsibility of the contestants to insure that their cook-off site is cleaned and all trash is taken to the dumpster provided. All fires must be extinguished; all building materials or props must be hauled away from site. Any equipment left on the premises after 1pm will become the property of the Saddle Up for Alzheimer's BBQ Cook-off committee. It is imperative that cleanup is thorough and timely.
- 5. **Sanitation**: Cooks are to prepare and cook in a sanitary manner as possible. Cook-off teams are responsible for keeping the contest area clean of trash.
- 6. **Open Fires**: All open fires/fire pits shall have a barrier around it. No ground fires. Teams must have a fire extinguisher readily available.
- Vehicle Traffic: All traffic lanes in the contest area must be open at all times. Vehicles will be allowed in cook-off area for drop off and pick up only on Friday from 9 am 11 pm and again on Saturday beginning at 5 am 10 am. Vehicle traffic access will be monitored and one vehicle will be allowed in camp site if space allows.
- 8. **Judging Trays**: A Styrofoam tray with hinged lid & foil paper will be provided with double number ticket. All judging containers shall be free of any markings.

- 9. **Prohibited**: No pets (except for service animals), no golf carts or ATV's will be allowed on the event grounds unless prior arrangements have been made with BBQ Cook off promoter.
- 10. **Categories Turn-times Quantity**: Will be decided by Head Judge prior to event.
  - a. The promoter and /or Head Judge will advise all cooks of the exact quantities and cuts of meat that will be placed in the judging trays.
- 11. **Turn-In Time**: Turn-in times for each IBCA meat category shall be pre-set. Once this time is set and/or announced no changes will be made. A turn-in window of ten (10) minutes before and after the set turn-in time will be recognized. Judging trays received after that time will not be accepted for judging.

#### 12. Turn in Times:

Friday: 8:30 P.M Chefs Choice.

Saturday: 10:00 A.M. Kids Q

11:00 A.M. Beans

12:00 Noon Chicken two (2) seperate1/2 fully jointed chicken halves

(to include breast, wing, thigh and drumstick.)

1:30 P.M. Pork Spare Ribs (9 individual pork spare ribs)

3:00 P.M. Brisket (9 Full Slices)

(Standard Turn-In Times Apply Up To 100 Teams)

- 13. **Judging**: All decisions of the Judges are final. Judging will consider Appearance, Aroma, Texture and Taste.
- 14. **Responsibility/Liability**: This is a family event. The Head Cook is responsible for the conduct of his/her team members and guests. The Saddle Up Cook-off Committee and volunteers are not responsible or liable for loss of items, damage of property, injury or accidents to any person entered as a contestant or any of the contestant's family members or guests.
- 15. **Prize money/trophies**: Winners will be announced on Saturday at approximately 6:00 pm.

1.	Check-in/ Kids cook meeting will be held on Saturday at 8:30 am Saturday. Turn-in will be Saturday at 10:00 am.		
2.	Kids (ages 5 – 15) will be able to compete		

- 3. One adult helper is allowed per team. Let's make sure to keep the kids safe so please have a responsible adult prepare and tend to fires as well as do any knife work. All other times the adult is to be hands off. The child must do the preparation, cooking and presentation. If the child is unable to do all of these he/she is too young to cook. Adult helper may do lighting of the grill and/or any slicing deemed too dangerous for the cook. The adult helper must be present at all times until the box is turned in.
- 4. 2 Pork Chops will be provided to each team.
- 5. You can use your own utensils, grills, seasoning and marinades. Please use food service gloves while handling meat. If you are unable to get any, please ask at the cooks meeting and we will provide you with some.
- 6. Open container, open garnish and open cooking fuel (gas, wood, charcoal, etc.).
- 7. Judging will be based on appearance, tenderness and texture. Nine being the highest and one being the lowest.
- 8. Must turn in 1 Pork Chop.
- 9. Awards will be handed out at the ceremony on Saturday evening at 6:00pm, trophies will be handed out along for 1st 3rd place and certificates for 4<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> place.
