## April 18<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup>, 2014 - IBCA Sanctioned & Judged BBQ Cook-off Rules and Regulations

- 1. Teams will consist of a Head Cook and up to four (4) team members.
- Any and all meat /or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event.
   Pre-cooking, marinating, etc, will not be allowed either on or off cook-off site prior to the start of the cook-off.

   Meats will be inspected.
- 3. Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start natural substance. (Not for full cooking) Holes or open pits are not allowed. Fires may not be built on the ground. <u>Each team must bring a fire extinguisher.</u> No fires are allowed using any type of treated wood or lumber. No railroad crossties, utility poles or treated lumber allowed.
- 4. Props, trailers, motorhomes, tents, and any other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the contestants' assigned space.
- 5. Dessert entry can be prepared and/ or cooked on site or at home. This is an open category.
- 6. Beans Dry Pinto Beans cooked on site. ( Nothing larger than the bean to be put into the turn-in cup.)
- Cooks Meeting will be held Saturday morning at 9:00 am in the judging area. <u>HEAD COOKS MUST ATTEND!</u>

A. ½ Chicken Halves
B. Pork Spare Ribs
C. Brisket
Fully joined split chicken (breast,wing,thigh,drumstick)
7 individual ribs (Minimum)
7 full width slices- approx.. 1/4" to 3/8" thick (Minimum)

Based on the number of cooks, turn in quantities are subject to change. No garnish sauce is allowed in the tray at turn-in. You may cook with sauce but it cannot be ladled onto the meat at turn-in.

- 8. It is the responsibility to the contestant to see that the contest area is kept clean & that the area is cleaned and policed following the contest. All fires must be put out, concrete blocks & other materials or props hauled away & all equipment removed from site.
- Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Alcoholic beverages rules must be followed (example: poured into cups). Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public. (Promoters Call) No drinking glass containers or bottles allowed.
- 10. No Extra vehicles will be allowed in the pit area once the pit is setup. Motor home is considered one (1) vehicle.
- 11. IBCA judging rules apply.
- 12. Promoter & cook-off officials will not be held responsible for accidents, theft, or any mishaps.
- 13. No animals allowed. No bicycles, skateboards, rollerblades, 3 or 4 wheelers, golf carts or battery powered vehicles allowed. (Cook-off official & security officers are exempt from this rule.)
- 14. All Profits go to the West Shore Volunteer Fire Department & other non-profit organizations to be used to benefit the Laguna Park community.
- 15. No live music or excessive loud music allowed in cook area.
- 16. No two (2) teams allowed to cook on the same pit.
- 17. No Water or Electricity hookups available.
- 18. West Shore Volunteer Fire Department BBQ directors reserve the right to disqualify any team that does not abide by the rules set by the Board of Directors
- 19. "Quiet Time" will be 12:30 am 7:00 am
