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Rules & Regulations

This event is in conjunction with Relay for Life Hale County with all the rules for judging as written by that organization and IBCA.

<u>TEAMS</u>: A team will consist of a Head Cook and assistants if needed. The Head Cook will be held responsible for the conduct of the team. Quiet time is from 1:00 am to 7:00 am Saturday and only moderate amplification during the day. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages, as well as disruptive behavior and or improper conduct, will be grounds for disqualification.

Vehicles must be parked outside of the cook-off area. No vehicles will be allowed in or out of the cook-off area. This is to keep from overcrowding and to allow easy access for Fire and EMS. Move out time will be after 6:00 pm Saturday, May 2nd, 2015. Each team will be assigned a 20×30 campsite. Water spaces are available on a first come first serve basis, bring your generators.

<u>COOKS MEETING:</u> A mandatory Head Cooks meeting will be held Friday, May 1st, 2015 at 8:30pm. Head cooks will be required to sign in at the meeting.

<u>COOKED ON SITE</u>: No pre-seasoning or pre-cooking allowed. All preparation of entries can begin after meat has been inspected by the promoter or an Official IBCA Head Judge. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies. There must be at least one (1) fire extinguisher per pit on site provided by the cook team.

<u>SANITATION</u>: Cooks are to prepare and cook in as sanitary manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by judging committee. Infractions identified by the judging committee shall be immediately corrected or the cook will be subject to disqualification. During and after the event we ask that trash be placed in the provided cans and/or dumpsters.

<u>ENTRIES PER PIT</u>: IBCA recognizes only one entry (one Head Cook) will cook on a given pit. It will be the responsibility of the promoters to monitor entries. Multiple entries in the same IBCA category by the same cook and/or multiple entries from the same piece of meat shall not be allowed. These are all grounds for disqualification.

BBOPITS: All fires must be in containers, not on the ground.

NO OPEN/GROUND FIRES ARE PERMITTED!

CATEGORIES:

BEEF BRISKET: Turn in seven (7) full ¼" to 3/8" slices.

PORK SPARE RIBS: Turn in 7 individual cut ribs (bone in) NO BABYBACKS. CHICKEN: Turn in a fully jointed ½ CHICKEN (to include wing, breast, leg and

thighs).

PORK: Pulled

BEANS: 16 Oz cup.

BEST CAMPSITE: Judging will be conducted by guest judges throughout the day. Teams will be judged on showmanship, campsite cleanliness, appearance and authenticity.

Barbeque will be judged on Aroma, Appearance, Color, Taste and Overall Impression. Judging will be under the direction of an IBCA Head Judge. <u>THE DECISIONS OF</u> THE JUDGES ARE FINAL.

<u>TURN IN TIMES</u>: Once the time is set and/or announced no changes will be made. A turn in window on ten (10) minutes before and after the set turn in times will be recognized. Judging trays received before or after that time will not be accepted for judging.

<u>PRIZES</u>: IBCA states that a Grand Champion be named at every cook-off. In the event of a tie for Grand Champion, brisket will be the first tie breaker, followed by ribs, then chicken.

We will award belt buckles to the Overall Winner, and the 1st places in the Beef Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs, and Chicken, and Pork Butt Divisions. We will have plaques for 2nd and 3rd places in the Beef Brisket, Pork Spare Ribs, and Chicken, and Pork Butt Division. Plaques will be awarded to the Best Campsite Award, Open category, Kids Q, Chili, and Jackpot Bean division. Prize money will be based off a standard payout schedule.

The committee has the right to change the prizes as needed.

No pets allowed. No skateboards, tricycles, bicycles, motorcycles, mopeds, three wheelers, four wheelers, or golf carts will be permitted inside the gates, with the exception of those used by Officials of the 3rd Annual Mark Marley Memorial BBQ Cook or handicapped individuals who have made arrangements with promoter prior to event.

Check in time will be Friday, May 1st, 2015 from 1:00 pm to 6:00 pm.

Winner of Best Campsite Award will be determined during the cook-off.

Neither the 3rd Annual Mark Marley Memorial BBQ Cook-off, Relay for Life of Hale County, American Cancer Society, City of Plainview, Hale County, Bobby Bouldin nor the Sponsors of this event will be held responsible for any theft or damage of property or bodily injury.

The 3rd Annual Mark Marley Memorial BBQ Cook off reserves the right to adjust regulations as situations warrant. Decisions of the 3rd Annual Mark Marley Memorial BBQ Cook off and Judge(s) will be final.
