Rules and Regulations

1. Creekside Christian Fellowship will not be held responsible for any theft, damage, or bodily injury.
2. This cook off will be sanctioned and judged by the I.B.C.A.
3. There will be no lewd or inappropriate acts or behavior allowed on the grounds of the BBQ Cook-off by cookers, guests, staff, etc. Any cookers found participating in or allowing inappropriate activities in their tent area will be disqualified from the Cook-off, the cooker's event will be shut down, and the team involved will be removed from the premises immediately and not allowed to participate in future CCF BBQ Cook-offs. Security officers will be permitted to all areas of the Cook-off, including all Cook-off team tents, etc. and will have authority to handle matters in accordance with the law.
4. The public consumption of alcohol is prohibited on church grounds and will not be tolerated; any public alcohol consumption will result in immediate dismissal from the contest and church grounds.
5. Only one team per pit.
6. Trophies and prize money will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place in each category; amounts are 1st - \$100, 2nd - \$75, 3rd - \$50.
7. An Overall Champion will be determined by a point system based on the judging of the brisket, chicken and rib categories, and will be awarded a trophy and \$100.
8. No pre-seasoned or precooked meat will be allowed. All meat must be cooked on site, the day of the contest.
9. Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start natural substance, but not to complete cooking. Holes or open pits are not permitted, and fires may not be built on ground.
10. Each team must provide a fire extinguisher and drip bucket.
11. Only one vehicle per team will be allowed in the cooking area and must be contained within the teams designated space. Motor homes will be considered one vehicle. Additional space may be purchased for \$60.
12. All vehicle traffic in the cooking area will be stopped on Friday night by 9:00pm. Vehicles will not be allowed in on Saturday morning.
13. It is the contestant's responsibility to clean their designated area after the contest ends. All contestants must clear the premises no later than 10pm, Saturday, April 26th.
14. Cooking areas will be assigned upon check in, unless you have reserved a spot with . Check in will be Friday, May 1, 2015, between 8 am and 10 pm.
15. Electricity will not be provided, generators are allowed.

16. Entry containers will be distributed at the **Mandatory Head Cooks Meeting**, Friday night at 7:00 pm in the judging area. Any container that has been altered will be disqualified. If another container is needed, one will be provided. Head cook must attend cooks meeting.

Turn-in times and requirements for each category are as follows:

7:00 pm Friday	Mandatory Head Cooks Meeting
8:30 pm Friday	Wild Game Category
10:30 am Saturday	Beans: Dry pinto beans cooked on site, there can be nothing larger than the bean in turn-in cup.
12:00 pm Saturday	Chicken: 1/2 fully jointed domestic chicken that includes a breast, wing with tip, thigh, and drumstick.
1:30 pm Saturday	Pork Spare Ribs: 7 individual ribs (bone-in).
3:00 pm Saturday	Brisket: 7 full width slices (approx. 1/4" to 3/8" thick)

17. All loud music will be turned down by 11:00pm Friday nights. Please be respectful to your neighbors and turn your speakers in towards your cooking area. Music of a vulgar nature will not be tolerated.

18. There will be no food or beverage items sold or distributed by any contestant.

19. Winners will be announced and trophies will be awarded at 5 pm Saturday May 2nd.

21. No skateboards, skates, bicycles, or golf carts allowed.

22. The Committee reserves the right to make additional regulations as situations may warrant.
