You will be provided with a little pit, the charcoal, the pork loin chops, and a variety of seasonings. You provide the good time and tasty turn-ins!

Parents should fill out the entry form and pay a \$25 entry fee. The first 30 entries registered will be able to cook. Each child cooking must have adult supervision with them at all times.

The competition meat provided will be two (2) 1 ½" inch thick pork loin chops. No garnish is allowed in the competition meat turn in box.

Included in the entry fee is an optional competition called The Cook's Choice.

The Cook's Choice can be a hot dog, a hamburger patty, steak, a chicken thigh, breast or leg or whatever you can cook in approximately 1-1/2 hours. The Cook's Choice may be garnished in anyway, but you must provide the items used to garnish the container.

Everyone will get to take home the pit you cook on. 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners in each category will win a Medal. All contestants will earn a certificate of participation in each category.

KID'S Q BARBEQUE COOKING CONTEST

Rules and Information

No one under the age of 6 or over the age of 17 may participate. A grown up MUST be with you at all times during cooking. Judging will be done in two age groups: Junior's 6 - 10 and Senior's 11 - 17.

We will also have a Cook's Choice competition. You can cook a hot dog, hamburger patty, a chicken leg, wing, breast or thigh, a steak or whatever you would like to turn in for the Cook's Choice. This part of the competition is voluntary so you do not have to participate. You must provide your own meat and you will cook your Cook's Choice item on the same pit as the competition meat. Cook's Choice meat must be turned in at 10:00am. You may not season or marinate your Cook's Choice meat until you are checked in at the cook off site on Saturday morning.

Everyone will cook on the same type of pit and use the same type of charcoal. Each contestant will be provided two pork loin chops 1-1/4" thick. These chops may be seasoned in any way using the seasonings provided OR you may bring your own seasonings. Turn in will be at 10:45am. Parents will be allowed to help start the fire, and they can help you turn the chops if you aren't tall enough to do so without burning yourself.

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Rule #1 You must listen to the Judging Official during cooking because it is important that no one gets hurt. If you are asked to stop doing something, it is to keep you safe.

Rule #2 An adult must accompany every participant at all times.

RULES & REGULATIONS

GENERAL

This event is sanctioned by the **International BBQ Cookers Association (IBCA)**; all rules for judging as written by that organization. Membership in the IBCA is not required.

- 1. All entry fees must accompany the application of \$185.00 + open category (optional \$20.00). Each team will receive a total of 5 wrist bands for the chief cook and 4 additional cooks.
- 2. It is the responsibility of the BBQ cooking teams to keep their area clean and assist in garbage disposal. All teams must provide a garbage can trash bags and pick up will be provided.

NO ONE WILL BE ALLOWED TO ENTER BEFORE NOON ON THURSDAY. ITEMS BROUGHT IN ARE FOR DROP OFF ONLY; NO FIRES ARE TO BE BUILT. THE GROUNDS WILL CLOSE AT 7:00 p.m. THURSDAY AND REOPEN FRIDAY MORNING.

- 3. Check in will begin at 8:00 AM on Friday, June 10th 2016. All teams must be checked in and set up by 5:00 PM on Friday June 10th 2016. All teams must be moved out by 1:00 PM on Sunday. No vehicles are allowed in or out between the hours of 5:00 p.m. Friday and 7:00 a.m. Saturday, and 10:00 a.m. Saturday until 1:00 p.m. on Sunday. Vehicles still on-site after the designated removal times will be towed.
- 4. Each BBQ cooking team must provide all supplies and equipment needed.
- 5. There will be ice available for purchase on site.

There will be limited spaces with ELECTRICTY available to teams for an additional fee of \$40.00 for weekend on a first requested basis. Please email me at davwilson5@yahoo.com if you are interested in a space with electric. Spaces will be 40x40. Pop-ups, trailers, and motor homes are allowed but you must provide your own generator. Vehicles and other equipment may not exceed the boundary of the assigned space. Water is located in the general cook-off area. Generators must be quiet or muffled. Port-a-cans will not be available for rent day of check in but will be available on site for public use. If you need a port-a-can for your space you will need to order with your team entry.

6. Fires must be of wood or wood substance. No gas or electric fires will be permitted. Holes, dug pits or open flames in boxes or other containers resting on or less than two feet above the ground are not permitted. No open flames of any kind are permitted (i.e., tikki torches or camp fires). No stakes, spikes or poles, etc. may be put in the ground.

- 7. It is the responsibility of the BBQ cooking teams to keep their area clean and assist in garbage disposal. All teams must provide garbage can(s) and trash bags for their own use and to be removed by 1:00pm on Sunday, June 12th. Each team is responsible for bagging and disposing of their trash into the dumpster provided. PLEASE DO NOT DUMP ASHES ON THE GROUND. EXTINGUISH ALL ASHES BEFORE DEPARTING THE COOK-OFF.
- 8. Each Chief Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team members and all guests. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to the general public by contestants. Each team must keep their alcohol supply out of sight. No open display of large quantities will be allowed. Please be as discreet as possible. All alcoholic beverages must be consumed within the perimeters of the cook-off area only.

NOTE: STATE LAW REQUIRES THAT ALL PERSONS MUST BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OF AGE TO CONSUME ALCOHOL.

- 9. Chief Cooks Meeting will be held Friday at 6:00 p.m. Only the Chief Cook needs to attend this mandatory meeting. At this time you will be given your containers for the contest.
- 10. QUITE TIME IS 12 MIDNIGHT...PLEASE!!!!This will be a BBQ cook off, not a battle of the amps! ALL music will be kept to a responsible roar and must be turned off by 12:00 midnight. And it is the chief cook's responsibility to enforce. **Please remember this is a family event when making your music selections.

11. Move In Abbreviated: Thursday, Noon – 7:00 p.m. (DROP OFF ONLY)

Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. Saturday, 7:00 a.m. - 10:00 a.m.

- All other times the Cook-off area is locked down and no vehicles except committee vehicles are allowed to be moving in the area.
- Only two (2) vehicles will be allowed in a team's space (only trucks, cars, motor homes or travel trailers.) These vehicles are not to be moved until 7:00 a.m. on Sunday morning. Absolutely no motorized vehicles, motorcycles, golf carts, scooters, etc.
- When move in and set up is complete, vehicles should be moved and parked in public parking lot. Empty vehicles outside team space are subject to being towed.
 - All vehicles except those staying in a team's space must be removed by 5:00 p.m. on Friday and 10:00 a.m. on Saturday.
- 13. The cook-off is located at the Montgomery County Fairgrounds 9055 Airport Rd. Conroe, TX 77303

A. SANITATION/FOOD SAFETY:

1. Cooks are to prepare and cook barbecue in as sanitary a manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to random inspection by the COOK-OFF JUDGING COMMITTEE, the IBCA, and/or County and State Health Inspectors. Conditions found to be unsanitary will be grounds for disqualification from this cook-off. However, it is the responsibility of each team to ensure that they have the following food safety items:

- Fire Extinguishers with a minimum rating of 2-A, 10-B: C with a current tag from a licensed extinguisher company; you will also need to bring the correct extinguishers for gas if using a propane grill for sides or non-competition foods.
- Plastic Single-Use Serving Gloves
- Liquid Dish/Hand Soap
- Paper Towels
- Trash Cans

B. COOKING & JUDGING:

- 1. The contest will be conducted under IBCA rules. www.ibcabbq.org
- 2. Fires must be of wood or wood substance. No gas or electric fires will be permitted.
- 3. No contest meats can be cooked, salted, seasoned or marinated prior to arrival of the cook-off.
- 4. You may COOK with sauce but DO NOT add sauce, marinade, sop, or juice to the meat once the meat has been placed in the container.
- 5. Chief Cook's meeting will be at 6pm on Friday evening; containers will be at this time.
- 6. Turn-in times for each category are pre-set. A turn-in window of ten (10) minutes before and after the set turn-in times will be recognized. Judging trays received after that time will not be accepted by the IBCA Judging Official. In the event of any emergency the Judging Official has the authority to make a time change with proper notification to the cookers.
- 7. All garnishes and condiments are prohibited, as they do not reflect true quality of the cooked meats. Meats may be cooked with sauces and/or other liquids, but once the cooking is complete, sauces, seasonings and/or liquids may not be added once put into the tray. ADDITIONALLY, CONTAINERS THAT ARE UNABLE TO CLOSE COMPLETEY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED BY THE JUDGING OFFICIAL.

F. MUSIC and BANDS

Music, bands, and/or sound equipment within your team area is allowed. HOWEVER, excessive loud music and/or sounds which interfere with announcements, scheduled live bands and entertainment on stage, or which intrudes upon or interferes with the comfort of fellow contestants will NOT BE ALLOWED OR TOLERATED. Offenders will receive no more than three (3) warnings from either the Barbecue Chairman, Director, Vice-Chairman or Security Vice-Chairman and non-compliance will be grounds for disqualification from the Cook-off and expulsion from the Barbecue Cook-off Grounds.

G. ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION & CONDUCT:

The Chief Cook for each team will be responsible for the conduct of his team, guests or invitees. As well, the Chief Cook will be responsible for his team's compliance with the rules and regulations herein set forth. Teams are permitted to bring their own alcoholic beverages to the QCCC event. Contestants must not give, offer, sell, or donate alcoholic beverages to the general public. Additionally, teams will not offer Barbecue for SALE. QCCC encourages that all teams and guests of the QCCC drink responsibly. Local law enforcement authorities will be present at the QCCC Cook-off reserves the right and discretion to disqualify and/or remove any team or guests that appear unruly or pose a danger to other guests at the QCCC is not responsible for any alcohol related incidents that occur outside the confines of the Lake Conroe event center.

Any nudity, lewdness, or any form of vulgarity will NOT be allowed. NO pyrotechnics or explosives are allowed. Any intentional use of the above by a team will result in disqualification, removal from grounds and possible elimination from any future QCCC Cook offs

H. ADMINISTRATION

- 1. Q'ING to CURE CHILDHOOD CANCER reserves the right to modify or expand these rules and regulations as warranted.
- 2. Decisions of the QCCC Executive Board, Judging Official and the judges will be final.
- 3. Security and safety are the sole responsibility of each contestant. QCCC and The Montgomery County Fairgrounds are not responsible for theft of or damage to the property of a contestant, its members or guests. Further, JIBTCF, QCCC & the Montgomery County Fairgrounds are not responsible for any injury to any such person. It is the contestant's responsibility to protect machinery, perishables and exhibits so no injury will result to the public, visitors, guests, persons or property. If property does not appear to be properly maintained, it will be promptly withdrawn from the cook off site. All property of the contestant including food stuffs and other perishables is understood to remain in the contestants care, custody and control within the confines of the cook-off area and are subject to the rules and regulations expressed within. The contestant, on signing the application, expressly release, hold, keep, save harmless and indemnify the persons and entities, named organizations and committees, and individuals from all claims for such loss, damage or injury.
