BBQ COOK-OFF RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. One team per pit, maximum 5 members per team.
2. Decisions of the Committee Chairman and Judges are final.
3. IBCA rules adhered to. Copies available at the registration desk.
4. The chief cook will be held responsible for the conduct of their team and guests.
5. Contestants must supply all needed equipment and supplies (except judging containers).
6. BBQ cook-off officials and Possum Hollow will not be held responsible for accidents or for theft or damages to equipment or property or persons.
7. All teams are responsible for keeping their space provided clean at ALL times and for the final cleanup of said space. All food must be prepared in a sanitary manner.
8. Contest meat may not be started cooking before 6:00 P.M. Friday May 2nd.
9. Random inspection of all meats could occur before 6:00 P.M. on Friday May 2nd by BBQ Committee. If the committee has not inspected you by 6:00 P.M. you may begin cooking.
10. NO GARNISH or SAUCE is allowed in the tray at turn-in. Meats may be cooked with sauce and/or other liquids, but cannot be added after the meat is placed in the judging tray. No puddling in bottom of tray.
11. Fires must be wood or charcoal. Pit may include gas or electricity to start the natural substances, **but not to complete the cooking.** No fires on ground. Each team must bring a fire extinguisher.
12. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Alcoholic beverages are allowed, must be 21 or over and not distributed to the general public. Samples are allowed to be given to the general public if you wish.
13. No animals allowed in cook-off area, with exception of Seeing Eye Dogs.
14. 1 vehicle per cook site. Cook site will be in the RV park at your hook-up site or designated area.
15. Categories to be judged are as follows: 1/2 fully jointed chicken, pork spare ribs (St. Louis cut acceptable) 7 individual ribs, Brisket, 7 full slices (approx. 1/4" to 3/8" thick). Jackpot Salsa and Jackpot beans, nothing larger than the bean in turn in cup.
