1. Each team will be responsible for their site and necessary cooking items.
2. Contestants must provide their own equipment and supplies. (Water and Generators)
3. It is the responsibility for the Head Cook to see that the contest area is kept clean and the area is cleaned following the contest.
4. The Head Cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team.
5. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages in the cook area will not be permitted.
6. Neither Rockin' "R" nor the IBCA committee will be responsible for theft, damage of property, or accidents.
7. No ground fires allowed. No gas cooking (except for beans). Wood substance only.
8. No multiple entries will be allowed. Only one team entry per pit.
9. Any and all meat/ and or meats that may be entered into judging will be cooked from scratch within the constraints of the event. Pre-cooking, marinating, pre-season, etc. will not be allowed until meats are inspected for the cook-off as defined by the cook promoter.
10. No garnish/sauces are allowed on the contest meat or the tray at the time of the turn in. You may cook with sauce.
11. Contestants must have fire extinguisher on their set up.
12. The cook-off promoter reserves the right to make modifications to the rules and regulations as situations warrant, any modifications will be relayed to all competition teams.
13. All decisions by the cook-off promoter and IBCA judges are final.
14. There will be trash cans and dumpsters provided, please keep your area clean and throw all trash away in dumpsters.
15. Head Cook meeting will start @8am. Saturday March 14, 2015.
16. Turn in times are as follow:
 - Beans: 10:00a.m.
 - Fajitas: 11:00a.m.
 - Chef choice: 12:00p.m.
 - Chicken: 1:00p.m.
 - Spare Ribs: 2:30p.m.
 - Brisket: 4:00p.m.
17. Music within your team is allowed. Excessive loud music will not be allowed or tolerated.
18. Any nudity, lewdness, or any form of vulgarity will not be allowed. Any intentional use of the above will result in disqualification.
19. Teams will be allowed to set up on Thursday, March 12th, any time after 12pm.
