CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) helps children who've been abused or neglected by providing a dedicated volunteer advocate to speak up for their best interest in court, at school and the community. CASA is the only child advocacy group working in the court system that provides a caring, consistent adult focused on a child's wellbeing for an entire year and often longer. All funds will go directly to fill the needs of children recovering from abuse or neglect.

Maggie's Hope is a non- profit organization with ZERO overhead, their goal is to obtain knowledge, promote awareness and most importantly support those families affected by <u>Autism</u> diagnosis. Many parents of Autistic children struggle to pay for treatments that might help their child's condition. Maggie's Hope was established to GRANT monies to families to assist with their needs, no matter what treatment path they may choose. The monies donated through the VFW fundraiser will stay in Central Texas to help families right here at home conquer their fight with <u>Autism</u>.

Honor Flight Austin is dedicated to providing a trip of a lifetime to our World War II Veterans to see their monument in Washington DC. These Golden Veterans are flown to Washington D.C, provided with hotels for one night and then a special tour of all the war memorials in the Washington D.C. area.

These programs are of the highest importance to Central Texas region. Your help with these worthwhile programs will be appreciated now and in the future
