

## 2019 Jackpot Fajita & IBCA Sanctioned BBQ Cook-off Rules and Regulations



# NEW RULE CHANGES—PLEASE READ

### **INTRODUCTION**

- 1. The sole purpose of this cook-off is to promote the Texas Rice Festival, and to supply information regarding dates and times of shows and performances.
- 2. Contestants will be selected on a first come, first serve basis. Limitations will be made on this basis if need be. Prior year contestants have 1st priority if entry postmarked by August 31, 2019
- 3. Contestants must provide all needed equipment and supplies.
- 4. Holes or dug pits are not permitted. Heat shields must be provided for cookers that are capable of damaging the contest area. Fires must be contained and be wood substance.
- 5. The Texas Rice Festival or its governing body will not be held responsible for theft, damage, or accidents.
- 6. The committee chairman reserves the right to make additional regulations as situations warrant. Decisions of the committee chairman, lead IBCA judge, and judges are final.
- 7. Those attending or participating in the Texas Rice Festival Cook-off are always required to wear appropriate clothing (No one will be allowed to go without shoes or shirts).

## **ADMINISTRATION**

- 1. <u>"LIMIT OF 60 TEAMS"</u> Entries should be submitted by September 27, 2019 but will be taken as space allows. Prior year entrants will be given priority if entry is postmarked by August 31, 2019.
- 2. Corporate Sponsors will be allowed to set up early by contacting Peanut or Glenn.
- 3. Check in is Friday, September 27, from Noon 6:00 p.m. Once checked in teams may begin cooking. All meat must be refrigerated or on ice at check in. (see individual contest rules) space will be available after 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, September 26, 2019. Your previous year's space <u>CAN</u> be reserved if payment and entry are postmarked before August 31. <u>Reserved spots may set up beginning</u> <u>Wednesday. at noon but no tents can be erected before noon Thursday to allow RV's to set up</u>. All other spaces are first come, first serve. The BBQ area must be empty for the committee to properly mark spaces. <u>PITS PULLED IN PRIOR TO THURSDAY AT 11:00 A.M. WILL BE TOWED AT THE</u> <u>CONTESTANTS EXPENSE.</u>
- 4. Teams are responsible for cleaning and policing their own area. Trash bins will be placed throughout the contest area for contestants to use.
- 5. Each team will be given a 40 X 40 space. Props, trailers, motor homes, vehicles, tents, awnings, or any other part of equipment or set up must not exceed the boundaries of the assigned space. Only 2 vehicles will be allowed in each space if space allows.
- 6. The chief cook will be held responsible for the conduct of his team and invited guests. Under NO circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to minors. Teams are welcome to bring in their own alcohol, however glass bottles are prohibited. <u>All music must be held at a moderate level while in the contest area. No Bands allowed. Consideration to your fellow cookers and festival goers is a must.</u>
- 7. No Vehicles will be allowed to enter or leave the contest area after 5:00pm Friday. Cookers needing to enter, or leave should contact a committee person for assistance.
- 8. <u>Parking and/or driving will not be permitted on the street during contest.</u> The free parking lots across the street should be used. <u>Violators will be towed at the owner's expense.</u>
- 9. Texas Rice Festival BBQ Committee members have free access to contestant's area.
- 10. Contestants are not allowed to bring in golf carts, motorcycles, or motorized vehicles.
- 11. Teams should conduct themselves in a manner that is suitable for family participation. Any contestant or teams who display indecent signs and apparel, or who are excessively loud will be asked to leave the contest area and forfeit their entry fee.

### COOKING

Jackpot Fajita Rules: Judging 7:30 p.m. Friday, 9/27/19 70% Payback 2 Places

- 1. There will be one division; **Beef Only!** Meat may be pre-seasoned or marinated.
- There is no minimum on the amount of fajitas cooked. Contestants must cook enough fajitas for (6) judges. "<u>PLEASE NO PICO DE GALLO!"</u>
- 3. Fajita meat must be refrigerated or on ice at time of check in and will be inspected by the chairman or a committee member.
- 4. Fajita Cooking may begin any time after inspection.

#### Jackpot Rice Rules: Judging 8:30pm Friday,9/28/19 100% Payback 2 Places

- 1. Rice must be a primary ingredient.
- 2. Must be prepared on site, may be prepared in any manner.
- 3. Judging based on flavor, originality and presentation.

#### PRIZES & AWARDS

Example: Based on 55 Teams = \$2340/Division Grand Champion - \$400 Reserve Champion - \$200 1<sup>st</sup> Place \$470, 2<sup>nd</sup> Place \$420, 3<sup>rd</sup> Place \$350, 4<sup>th</sup> Place \$280 5<sup>th</sup> Place \$260, 6<sup>th</sup> Place \$210, 7<sup>th</sup> Place \$190, 8<sup>th</sup> Place \$160

#### SHOWMANSHIP RULES: Grand Champion

- 1. Showmanship will be judged on theme, costumes, booth set-up, action and audience appeal. Judging will be done by anonymous judges.
- 2. Sound amplification must be on limited volume so as not to interfere with other contestants. No firearms of any kind will be allowed in the Park.
- 3. A showmanship team must have entered all 3 divisions to qualify for showmanship points.
