



The IBCA organization and all volunteers will not be held responsible for any damages due to accident, theft or injury.

All cook-off teams are required to submit an entry form for this event. The entry application and entry fee entitles the cooking team to one cook-off space and entry fees for brisket, pork spare ribs, and chicken at a rate of \$200.00. Entry fees must be received at time of application. No credit can be extended.

- 1. Cook-off Entry: Entry forms will not be accepted without full payment of entry fee and are accepted on a first-come/first-serve basis until all spaces have been taken.
- 2. Each team must have and cook on their own pits, **No Sharing of Heat Sources**. Cooking team members may not cook for more than one team in the competition. Each Head Cook is required to attend the Head Cook's meeting at 6:00 pm on Friday. The Head Cook is responsible for the operation of the team space and all actions by members and guests of their cooking team within or outside of the designated space. The Head Cook must be onsite and available to the BBQ Committee if necessary.
- 3. Competition Categories and Rules: Meat categories to be judged will be: Chicken two (2) separate 1/2 fully jointed chicken halves (to include breast, wing, thigh and drumstick.), Pork Spare Ribs (9 individual pork spare ribs), Brisket (9 Full Slices)
- 4. Additional competition categories: Beans (Start with dry pinto beans only), Margaritas (Anything goes) Open (NO DESSERTS), Kids Q (Two boneless pork chops provided by promoter NO GARNISH ALLOWED foil in the bottom of the tray).
- 5. Cook-off Site Setup Times: Setup will be on Friday beginning at 12:00 pm (noon) and ending at 6:00 pm. At 6:00 pm vehicle access to the cook-off area will be blocked for security purposes. No extra vehicles will be allowed in the cooking area after 6:00 pm. Any vehicle parked outside of the cook-off teams boundaries after the designated time may be towed at the owner's expense. In case of emergency, shuttle carts/vehicles will be provided to move supplies for teams. Sites will be approximately 40' x 40' or as otherwise marked. Team equipment and decorations must fit within the area assigned. No electricity or sewer is available. Porta-cans will be provided. All tent structures or canopies must be secured with tent stakes, water barrels or other weighted devices. Digging of holes into the ground is prohibited.
- 6. Equipment: Cooking teams will be provided with a space only. Cooking teams must supply all necessary equipment and supplies. All teams are required to have a fire extinguisher present during times of cooking. Committee personnel may randomly inspect the cooking team's equipment. All equipment is the sole responsibility of the cooking team and may not extend at anytime outside of the designated cooking team space. Fire holes or open pits are not permitted.

BBQ pit fires must be of wood or wood substance. BBQ pits may include gas or electricity to start your fire only, but once the cooking of meats start it must be wood substance only.

- 7. Entries Per Pit Each team must have and cook on their own pit. More than one pit can be used by an individual team but pits cannot be shared by multiple teams. Only one entry in each cook-off category can be submitted for Judging by a given team.
- 8. Behavior and Conduct: Head Cooks are responsible for the conduct of their team members and guest.
- a. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages may be grounds for disqualification. Under NO circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to anyone under the age of 21. Each team must monitor its own area as it pertains to minors. Cook-off committee members or their agents will be permitted to all areas of the cook-off and will have authority to handle matters in accordance with the law.
- b. No drinks, goods or food sales are permitted to the general public by anyone except those authorized by the cook-off chairman.

- c. There will be no lewd, violent or inappropriate acts, behavior or events allowed on the grounds of the BBQ cook-off by cookers, guest, staff, etc.
- d. All minors must be properly supervised at all times by an adult parent or guardian. Any person having a minor deemed by the Security Officer to be unruly or dangerous will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- e. All pets must be leashed and properly supervised at all times. Any person having an animal deemed by the Security Officer to be unruly or dangerous will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- 9. House Keeping: Each team will be responsible for cleanup within their assigned space in a timely manner. Garbage cans will be provided. Periodic trash pick-up will be provided. Each team should bring an additional supply of trash liners for their own use. Upon check out each team is required to place excess trash, debris, etc. in the dumpsters provided.
- 10. Entertainment: Outside entertainment will not be allowed in team cooking areas. Radios shall be played at a reasonable sound level. Excessive noise will NOT be allowed between the hours of 12:00 am and 7:00 am. Pyrotechnics of any kind are strictly prohibited. Requests made by the Security Officer for noise to be adjusted must be obeyed.
- 11. Transportation: The use of motorized vehicles is prohibited in the cook-off area between 8:00 pm on Friday and 6:00 pm on Saturday except for cook-off committee members. Mobility vehicles and motorized wheel chairs are allowed only for those in need of such devises.
- 14. Clean Up: It is the responsibility of the contestants to see that their cook-off space is cleaned and all trash is taken to the provided dumpster prior to leaving. All fires must be extinguished and concrete blocks and other building materials and props must be removed from site. All equipment used by the team (including tents, canopies, RVs, etc.) is to be removed from the site by 4:00 pm on Sunday. Any property left on the premises after 4:00 pm Sunday will become the sole ownership of the Post 95 BBQ cook-off committee. Any space left in disarray or with loose or bundled trash, other than at trash containers, will disqualify the team from future participation in Post 95 BBQ cook-off events.

Any violation of these rules may be grounds for disqualification, eviction from the BBQ cook-off and/or denial of future participation. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be distributed to anyone under the age of 21. Each team must monitor its area as it pertains to these rules. The IBCA organization and all volunteers will not be held responsible for accidents, theft or damage to persons and/or equipment.

10:30 A.M. Beans: (Start with dry pinto beans only)

12:00 Noon Chicken two (2) seperate 1/2 fully jointed chicken halves

(to include breast, wing, thigh and drumstick.)

1:30 P.M. Pork Spare Ribs (9 individual pork spare ribs)

3:00 P.M. Brisket (9 Full Slices)
