# **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- 1) Contestants may begin checking in Friday April 24, 2020 at 9:00am. Deadline for checking in will be 6:00pm.
- 2) Teams will consist of one (1) Head Cook and Four (4) team members. Each team must cook on their own pit.
- 3) This is an IBCA Sanctioned event. Cooking rules and regulation plus meat turn in requirements can be found at <a href="https://ibcabbq.org/wp-content/uploads/IBCA-Rules-Sept-2019-Final.pdf">https://ibcabbq.org/wp-content/uploads/IBCA-Rules-Sept-2019-Final.pdf</a>
- 4) Head cook will be responsible for the conduct of his/her team and guest. The excessive use of alcoholic beverages shall be grounds for disqualification. This event is scheduled to take place on the property of the Wheelhouse. Pursuant to TABC regulations, alcohol may not be brought onto the premises of the Wheelhouse. Any alcohol consumed on the premises of the Wheelhouse must be purchased from the Wheelhouse. The Wheelhouse will offer discounted pricing to teams. Anyone caught bringing alcohol onto the premises of the Wheelhouse will be asked to leave the competition and will not be allowed to enter the competition. Under no circumstances are alcoholic beverages to be offered in any form to A MINOR, or general public. No alcohol is to leave the cook-off area.
- 5) It is the responsibility of the bar b q team to see that the contest area is kept clean, and the area is clean following the contest. The team will be required to dispose of their trash in the provided dumpsters.
- 6) Water and Electricity are not provided.
- 7) All items must be turned in at the time listed next to the corresponding items.

8) Judging quantities for special categories are listed below:

 $\ensuremath{\text{Beans}}$  – Dry Pinto Beans – cooked on site. (Nothing larger than the bean to be put into the turn-in cup.)

**Fan Favorite** – The event will be open to the public for taste testing. There is no entry fee to participate. The theme this year will be **CHICKEN** so any chicken themed dishes will need to be provided for tasting should you choose to enter. Serving dishes will be provided. Wrist bands will be sold to the public with a list of the teams participating and a grading scale on your provided dishes. The team with the highest scores at the end will be awarded Fan Favorite. The winner will receive the Fan Favorite Trophy. We expect a high volume of visitors so please keep that in mind.
