I.B.C.A. Rules and Regulations will govern this cook-off

1. ALL CONTESTANTS ARE EQUAL. There will be no Professional/Amateur Classifications.
2. ENTRIES PER PIT - Each team will consist of a chief cook and as many assistants as the chief cook deems necessary. Each team will provide a pit/pits to be used exclusively by that team within the team's assigned cooking space. All assigned cooking spaces will be a 40' x 40' area. The use of a single pit (cooking device) by more than one team is not permitted.
3. OPEN FIRES - No open pits or holes are permitted. Fires may not be built on the ground. A fire extinguisher device will be near all pits. Contestants must provide all needed equipment, supplies and electricity, except as arranged for in advance. Contestants must adhere to all electrical, fire and other codes whether city, county, state or federal.
4. COOKED ON SITE - All categories, IBCA meats and jackpots will be prepared and cooked on site. The preparation and completion of any and all meats and jackpots in competition is within the confines of the cook-off site and during the time limits designated by the promoter. All meats in competition are subject to inspection at any given time. Once meat has been inspected, it must not leave the contest site.
5. SANITATION - Cooks are to prepare and cook in as sanitary manner as possible. Cooking conditions are subject to inspection by the judging committee. Infractions identified by the committee are to be corrected immediately.
6. CATEGORIES –
  - Beans: 1 – 16oz container
  - Margaritas: 1- 16 oz. container
  - Chef's Choice – At least 12 bite size pieces
  - Chicken: Two (2) separate, 1/2 fully jointed chicken, (to include breast, wing, thigh and drumstick. SKIN ON (no Cornish game hens)
  - Pork Spare Ribs: Nine (9) individual cut ribs (bone in) (St. Louis Cut acceptable).
  - Brisket: Nine (9) full slices.
7. CAUSES FOR DISQUALIFICATION:
  - A. Excessive use of alcoholic beverages by a team, its members and/or guests
  - B. Use of controlled substances by a team, its members and/or guests.
  - C. Foul, abusive, or unacceptable language by a team, its members and/or guests.
  - D. Excessive noise generated from speakers or public address systems.
  - E. Excessive or continued complaints from teams about any of the above rule infractions shall be considered grounds for immediate disqualification from the contest by a GZS representative.
8. There will be no refund of entry fees for any reason, no rainouts.

9. Showmanship and cooking are separate entities and will be judged as such.
10. General Zaragoza Society will not be responsible for theft, damage or injury sustained during the cook-off. Cooking areas will be designated for each team. Entry fee must be paid in full before area can be reserved. A space will be assigned to each team. There is no electricity provided, generators are allowed. The promoter reserves the right to make additional regulations as situations warrant. Decisions of the promoter and Judges are final. Anyone violating cook-off rules may be disqualified.
